Boxers hence the number of ranked boxers will increase over the next few months as we gradually enter the digital ranking system in which all boxers will receive a ranking – all boxers must take note that you may appear on the rankings however that doesn't immediately ensure you a S.A Title challenge – many of you will still have to prove beyond doubt that you deserve a future opportunity to challenge for the National title. We hope that with the inclusion of more names to the rankings boxers shall be encouraged to become better at what they do – train that little bit harder – improve their skills – improve their record so their chances to compete for National titles shall become a reality.

To comply with International standards the following divisions shall henceforth be known as

Junior Heavyweight > Cruiserweight

Junior Middleweight > Super-Welterweight

Junior Welterweight > Super-Lightweight

Junior Lightweight > Super – Featherweight

Junior Featherweight > Super Bantamweight

Junior Bantamweight > Super-Flyweight

Junior Flyweight > Light-Flyweight

Mini-Flyweight > Minimumweight
