Heavyweight:

- Chris Thompson drops to no 3 after losing his last 3 contests

Welterweight:

- Bonke Duku enters at no 6 with a solid win over Wade Groth

Junior welterweight:

- Sanele Msimang moves to no 4 after beating Luvuyo Mphuthi
- Mphuthi drops to no 7

Featherweight:

- Lindelani Sibisi enters at no 10 after winning the KZN title
- Sithembiso Maduna drops out after his loss to Lindelani Sibisi

Junior featherweight:

- Mzuvukile Magwaza enters at no 8 after being removed due to inactivity
- Mxolisi Zuma enters at no 7 after winning the KZN title

Bantamweight:

- Lusizo Manzana returns to no 1 as he was removed in error. He had a fight arranged that was cancelled.
- Manelisi Ndlovu enters at no 9 with a win over former KZN champion Mxolisi Sibiya
